Corruption Risk Assessment

Procedures of import clearance by Maldives Customs Services

The Corruption Risk Assessment of Maldives Customs Service, which focused on 'Procedures of import clearance by Maldives Customs Services' was based on the recommendations provided in the Commissions' investigation case number ACC-2013/082.

The main objective of this research was to assess whether the laws and regulations regarding the import of goods and services into Maldives are followed, and to determine whether relevant actions are taken against importers who break the specific laws and procedures while importing goods into the country.

A qualitative approach was applied to conduct the research with use of semi-structured questionnaires as a tool to conduct interviews. Selected senior officials of the Maldives Customs Services, along with members of other institutions like Maldives National Defense Force (MNDF), Maldives National Chamber of Commerce (MNCC) and Maldives Association of Construction Industries (MACI) were interviewed, to gather primary data for the research.

The primary data was backed up by secondary data collected through evaluation of related laws and regulations and other documents of stakeholder institutions. In addition, statistics of MCS and documents relating to cases of submitting lower price to the customs were reviewed. This assessment was carried out through 2016 and 2017.

The findings of the research highlighted on issues related to laws and regulations. This include, evidence obtained through audits not complying to procedures stated in the law, registration of new companies due to termination of import license and lack of a whistleblower protection procedure. Procedural issues related to employees include, disclosure of employees financial statements and Inefficient rotation of technical staff. Other challenges such as difficulty in contacting companies and verifying the imported goods were also identified through the research. The paper also proposed recommendations that can help improve the identified issues.





Quarter Highlights

Civil Service Conference 2018

The Civil Service Conference 2018, was held from 14th to 15th April 2018 at Dharubaaruge. The main objective of the Conference which was themed, “Reforming and Modernizing Civil Service”, was to strengthen the governance of the civil service and to find innovative ways to modernize and reform the civil service systems and its operations, through research and discussions.

The paper presented by ACC titled, “Administrative negligence in Recruitment and Corruption Risks” was based on findings from cases investigated by the Commission regarding recruitment, and discussed how administrative negligence led to corruption risks. The paper also, highlighted recommendations on how to strengthen the recruitment system of the Maldives Civil Service, in a way that does not involve the risk of corruption.

Dhivehi Language Day 2018

A special ceremony was held on 15th April 2018, at ACC to celebrate Dhivehi Language Day 2018. The Chief Guest of the ceremony was Information Commissioner, Mr Abdul Azeez Jamal Abubakuru. The President of Dhivehi Bahuge Academy was also in attendance at the ceremony.

The Chairperson of the Commission, Mr Hassan Luthfee, Commission Member Ms. Aminath Minna, President of Dhivehi Bahuge Academy Mr Ashraf Ali and the Chief Guest, Information Commissioner Mr Abdul Azeez Jamal Abubakuru spoke at the ceremony and highlighted on the importance of strengthening and appreciating the language.

‘Kiyamaa Kiyamaa’ – Children’s event

A story-telling activity was conducted to promote integrity-awareness among young children, as part of the activities conducted by the ACC to mark the Dhivehi Language Day 2018. The activity named ‘Kiyamaa Kiyamaa’ was conducted on Saturday, 14th April, 2018, at Rasrani Bageechaa in Male’. Moral stories highlighting the importance of integrity were shared with the children who participated in the activity.

Handbook on Awareness Programs

A handbook which specifies details of the awareness programs conducted by the Commission was launched by Commission Member, Ms. Aminath Minna, during the National Anti-Corruption Day ceremony held at the Commission on 23rd April 2018. The handbook includes information about public awareness sessions conducted by the Commission and School Integrity program aimed at fostering culture of integrity in the society. Also, details on Social Audit Program and awareness sessions for public officials are included in the handbook.

National Anti-Corruption Conference 2017 – Official Book

The official book of The National Anti-Corruption Conference held on 10th -11th May 2017 in collaboration with the Islamic University of the Maldives was launched by the President of ACC, Mr. Hassan Luthfee, during the National Anti-Corruption Day ceremony held on 23rd April 2018. The book consists of research papers presented at the conference, conclusions and details of the conference proceedings. Furthermore, the declaration of the conference and road map to implement recommendations presented at the conference are included.



Statistics Book 2017

The ACC's Annual Statistics Book for the year 2017 was officially launched on 23rd April 2018 by the Vice President of ACC, Uz. Muaviz Rasheed in a ceremony held at the Commission to celebrate the National Anti-Corruption Day 2018. This publication gives information about the performance of the Commission for the year 2017. It includes comprehensive statistical information regarding cases lodged to the Commission, cases concluded, number of awareness programs conducted, number of recommendations issued and various other data on cases investigated.

Social Audit Pilot Survey Report

The Social Audit Pilot Survey Report was launched on 23rd April 2018 in the ceremony held to mark the National Anti-Corruption Day 2018. The report was launched by Chief Guest of the ceremony, State Minister Dr. Abdulla Nazeer.

The study conducted from 13th to 15th November 2017 at Fuvahmulaku City was focused on the project of Eco-Facility Development in "Fuvahmulaku Bandaara and Dhadimagu Kilhi". The Social Audit survey was the first of its kind in the Maldives and was initiated with the aim to train and empower the island stakeholders through increasing transparency and accountability in the governance system. This survey was conducted with financial support provided by the UNDP Maldives.

Children's Evening at Fiyavathi

A Children's Evening for children under state care at Fiyavathi in Hulhumale' was held on the occasion of The National Anti-Corruption Day 2018. Around 80 children from Fiyavathi took part in the Children's Evening. Several games were organised at the event, which took place on Saturday, 28th April 2018. ACC also made some donations to Fiyavathi. This includes a dough machine and repairing of two sinks and the related plumbing. Funds for this donation was raised by contributions from staff of ACC.

National Anti-Corruption Day – Official Ceremony

The ACC hosted the official ceremony for the National Anti-Corruption day on 23rd April 2018. State Minister, Dr. Abdulla Nazeer was the Chief Guest of the ceremony. In his speech, Dr. Abdhulla Nazeer emphasized on the importance of seeking higher educational opportunities in the field of anti-corruption. The President of ACC Mr. Hassan Luthfee, who also spoke at the ceremony advised the staff to speed up the investigation and increasing the number of cases concluded. He called upon the staff to strive towards reducing the number of pending cases to 500 by the end of this year.

ACC's Statistic Book for 2017 was also released during this ceremony. Moreover, our quarterly bulletin 'Bithufangi', Handbook on Training Programs of ACC, and the official book of Anti-Corruption Conference 2017 and Social Audit Pilot Survey Report was released during the ceremony. In addition to this, a presentation was also given focusing on the results of The Social Audit Pilot Survey. Furthermore, certificates were awarded to ACC's staff with the best attendance, and staff with appraisal score higher than 90 marks, as well as winners of the story writing competition.



Anti-Corruption Commission Recreation Club (ACCRC)

Foundation

The Anti-Corruption Recreation club (ACCRC), is an association formed and run by the staff of The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC). The association was initiated in order to strengthen and officially acknowledge the Staff Welfare Scheme, formerly managed by a welfare committee established among the staff. The founders of the association are Superintendent of Investigation Abdhul Azeez Moosa, Assistant Superintendent of Investigation Moosa Ali Didi and Senior Investigation Officer Majid Hassan. The main purpose of promoting from a welfare committee to an association was to formalize the welfare works of the committee as well as to establish a legal status as an association recognized by the law.

The ACCRC was registered on 17th November 2014 and officially inaugurated on 5th February 2015. The association's certificate of registration was presented to the President of ACCRC, Mr. Adam Shamil during the inauguration ceremony held on 5th February 2015. The letter was presented by the Chairman of the Welfare Committee Mr. Ahmed Ameen. According to the governing regulation of the association, the main objective of the association is:


1. To promote healthy relationship among all members

3. To promote members' welfare and provide assistance in all areas of need for the members.
4. To provide assistance in curbing corruption from Maldives
5. To participate in activities at national level that promote social welfare.

Membership
