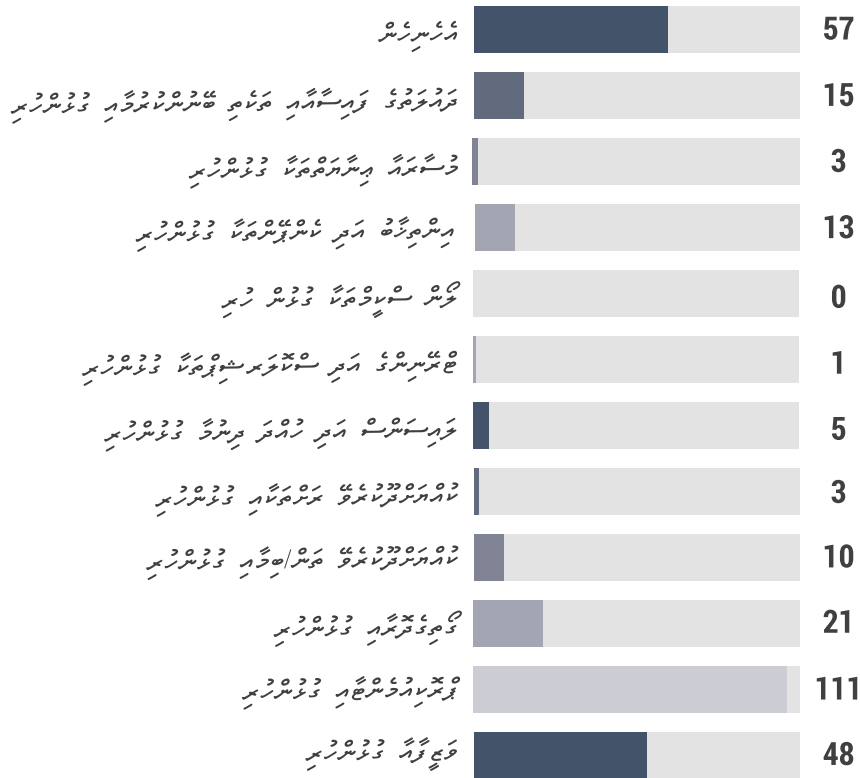

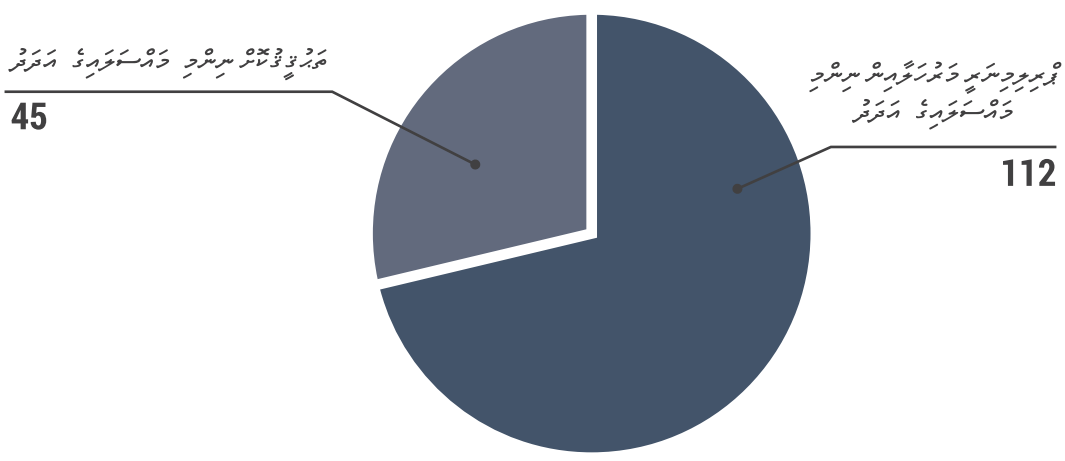

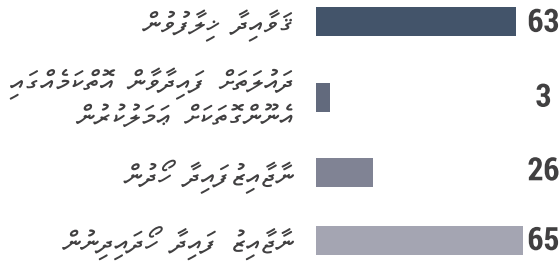

It was a one-day trip to Gulhifalhu where the participants had different set of activities and competitions amongst themselves. The aim of this trip was to create and strengthen the bond between the staff of ACC in an outside setting, free from work stress.

The ACCRC initiates this trip on an annual basis since the establishment of the Club.





Awareness Sessions for MAPS International High School students

An Integrity-Awareness programme has been conducted for grade 12, students of MAPS International High School, on 24th January 2019. A total of 29 students participated in the session held at the school.

The two-hour session highlighted the importance of academic integrity, good conduct, the importance of fighting against corruption, and ethical approaches for decision making. The session was conducted by professional staff of the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC).

Awareness Sessions for Villa International High School students

An Integrity-Awareness programme has been conducted for the newly joined grade 11 students of Villa International High School, from 4th to 10th February, 2019. A total of 267 students participated in the 5 sessions conducted at the school.

The programme of total ten-hours, highlighted the importance of academic integrity, good conduct, the importance of working against corruption, and ethical approaches for decision making. The sessions were conducted by professional staff of the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC).

ACC conducted a Training Session organized by President's Office

The ACC conducted an Anti-Corruption and Good Governance Sessions organized by the President's Office on 10th and 11th February 2019. The sessions were participated by newly selected political appointees and electoral candidates. The lack of a National Anti-Corruption strategy and its associated challenges were highlighted.

Meanwhile the session also briefed on the usual manners on how acts of corruption occurs in government institutions and companies alike, and means to overcome this. In total 116 participates attended the sessions. Vice President Uz. Muavviz Rasheed conducted these sessions on behalf of the Commission.

Public Officials Integrity Program - CSTI Session

The ACC has conducted an Anti-Corruption Training program for the Civil Service staff on 12th February, 2019, at the Civil Service Training Institute (CSTI). This program is part of the induction program organized by the CSTI, to give information on corruption and integrity to the participants.

The three-hour session with 18 participants from 8 different institutions was conducted by professional staff of ACC.

School Integrity Program for Students

An Integrity-Awareness programme has been conducted for the newly joined grade 11 students of Centre for Higher Secondary Education School (CHSE), on the 14th – 20th February, 2019. A total of 353 students participated in the 8 sessions taken at the school.

The programme of total twelve-hours highlighted the importance of academic integrity, good conduct, the importance of fighting against corruption, and ethical approaches for decision making. The sessions were conducted by professional staff of the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC).

Awareness Programs and Anti-Corruption Trainings


ACC Conducted a Training Programme in Collaboration with CMDA

An awareness session regarding Anti-Corruption, advancement of Integrity, and familiarization with procurement regulations has been conducted for public officials in senior posts of State Institutions and Private Companies. The 'Procurement Training' and 'Anti-Corruption Awareness Training' sessions were conducted by professional staff of the ACC at Directors Training Programme, organized by the Capital Market Development Authority (CMDA), on 15th January, 2019.

The two-hour thirty minutes' session was attended by a total of 27 participants from 19 different institutions. Participants signed the National Integrity Pledge after the session which was conducted at the Asaree Maalan of SHE building.



CMDA Training Sessions



This Conference took place in Vienna, Austria from 23rd to 24th January 2019, under its main theme “15 Years of the United Nations Convention Against Corruption: Accomplishments and Prospects”.

During the Conference, IAACA launched the Dr. Mahathir Mohamad Fund to help anti-graft officers who face risks in their line of duty.

Training Session on Dhivehi Language

On the occasion of the International Mother Language Day, a training session on Dhivehi Language and the proper ways to frame phrases in Dhivehi was conducted. The training took place in the Commission’s conference hall on the 21st February 2019. A total of 58 staff participated in this training.

Anti-Corruption Strategy Workshop

The ACC in collaboration with UNODC, conducted a workshop on developing a strategy to prevent and fight corruption. The workshop was held at ACC from 20th to 21st March 2019. The main objective of the workshop was to analyze the problems and challenges that are faced in carrying out the mandatory functions, and, by providing the solutions and good practices to tackle them.

The sessions were conducted by Ms. Zorana Markovic, UNODC Regional Anti-Corruption Adviser, and Mr. Davor Dubravica, the Expert Speaker. This two-day workshop gathered 30 staff from the relevant sections of ACC.

ACC conducted a Training Session on Report Writing

A Report Writing training session was conducted for the staff of ACC. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Ahmed Abdulla Saeed, an expert in journalism and report writing.

The main objective of this session is to allow employees to learn the various aspects of both planning and writing professional reports, and how to formulate reports that will match up to and meet the expectations of the reader.

The four-hour program held on 21st and 23rd March 2019, was attended by 69 staff from different sections of the Commission.

Workshop on Corruption Risk Assessment and Management

The ACC in collaboration with UNODC conducted a Workshop on Corruption Risk Assessment and Management. The workshop was held at ACC from 25th to 27th March 2019. It aimed to provide knowledge and insights on the UNODC methodology to identify the corruption risks and red flags that would assure the adoption of mitigation and prevention plan.

These sessions were conducted by Ms. Zorana Markovic, UNODC Regional Anti-Corruption Adviser, and Mr. Constantine Palicarsky, the Expert Speaker. In addition to the staff of ACC, other government entities related to corruption prevention participated in the workshop.

Release of MMPRC Report

On 14th February 2019, the Commission released its final report on the biggest corruption scandal the Maldives ever witnessed; “The Corruption of Maldives Marketing & Public Relations Corporation (MMPRC)”.

Launching of the Campaign against Election Corruption

The Commission announced its launching of the campaign on Corruptions related to Elections - 2019 on the 17th February 2019. The campaign was to promote integrity and make general public aware on the different means of corruption that can happen during the election campaigns and the importance of electing a candidate with integrity.

The news release on the website detailed the series of activities planned under this campaign.

Release of Annual Report 2018

On the 10th March 2019, ACC released its Annual Report of the Year 2018 on a special ceremony held for the occasion. The report was released by the Commission’s Vice President Uz. Muaviz Rasheed.

The report covered details of investigations conducted by the Commission along with the details of prevention work with the figures of awareness outreach programs conducted throughout the year of 2018. It also highlights administrative function and challenges faced by the Commission.

Trainings and Conferences

Training On Investigating Corruption Crimes

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) has conducted a training on investigating corruption crimes related to the offense of obtaining undue advantage by government employees, on 22nd January 2019.

The training session was focused on how to prove the criminal elements included in article 12 (a) of law number 2/2000 (Prevention and Prohibition of Corruption Act).

The three-hour training session was conducted by Legal and Asset Recovery Unit of the Commission for 40 Investigation Officers of ACC.

ACC participates in the 10th IAACA Annual Conference

The ACC participated in the 10th Annual Conference of the International Association of Anti-Corruption Authorities (IAACA). Commissioner Mr. Yazumeed Mohamed attended the conference on behalf of Anti-Corruption Commission.
