Overseas Trainings

UNODC Inter-Regional Workshop

The Commission participated in the Inter-Regional Workshop on the use of Open Source Data in Criminal and Financial Investigations of Corruption Crimes in South and Southeast Asia within the collaborative efforts of the UNODC “Asia-Pacific Joint Action Towards Global Regime Against Corruption” programme and the American Bar Association Rule of Law Initiative (ABA ROLI). Investigation Officer Uz. Ahmed Shaan Mohamed, Investigation Officer Ms. Mariyam Liusha and Assistant Investigation Officer Ms. Aminath Shafeeq participated in this workshop on behalf of the ACC.

This regional workshop held in Bangkok, Thailand from 18 to 20 September 2019, was aimed to provide an insight on specialized skills and tools to investigators. It also focused on the definition, scope and applicability of open source data and intelligence in criminal and financial investigations of corruption crimes.

Intelligence Based Investigation Training Program

ACC had participated in a training program on Intelligence based Investigation, organized by Malaysian Anti-Corruption Academy (MACA). It was held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia from 8th to 10th July 2019. The program was mainly aimed to develop knowledge on all aspects of the intelligence based investigation procedures. Assistant Investigation Officers Mr. Ibrahim Ali and Mr. Hussain Nuhaadh attended this training on behalf of the ACC.



Public Finance Regulation Awareness workshops

Public Finance Regulation awareness workshop for public officials of K. Huraa was conducted on 31st July 2019, in collaboration with the Secretariat of Huraa Council. A total of 13 participants from 4 different institutions had participated in this 6-hour workshop.

Another Public Finance Regulation workshop was held on 18th August 2019 for the staff of Ministry of Tourism. This session was attended by a total of 35 participants.

Awareness Sessions for teachers of Jamaluddin School

An Integrity-awareness programme was conducted for the teachers of Jamaluddin School on 01st August 2019. A total of 163 staff participated in this session which was held at the school.

The two and half hour session covered the importance of academic integrity, good conduct, the importance of fighting against corruption, and 5 ethical approaches for decision making.
