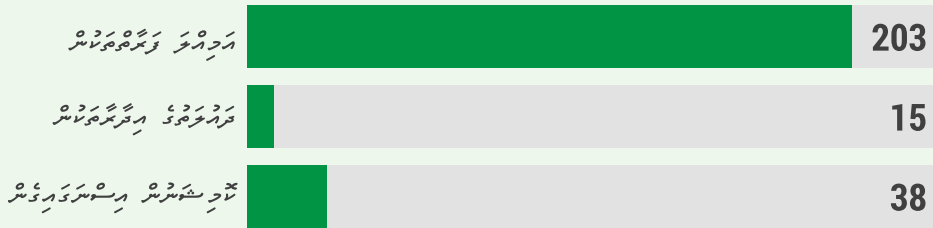

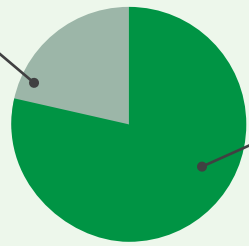

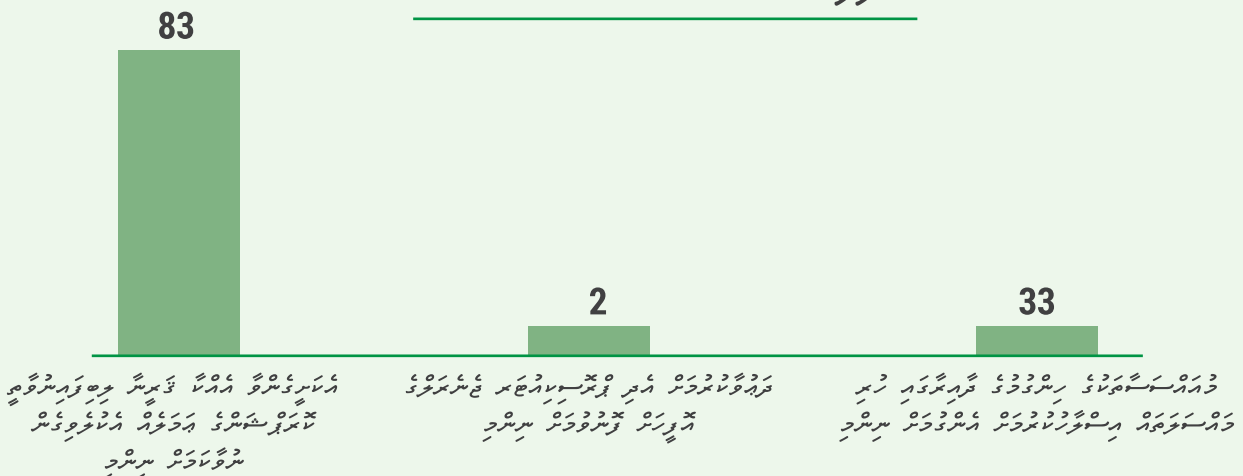

A third round of awareness session were held at L. Fonadhoo under “Masalas Raajje national awareness campaign, which focused on the local council elections.

A total of 2 sessions with 70 participants from different islands of L. Atoll have been conducted on Monday, 2nd March 2020 and Tuesday, 3rd March 2020. The participants included candidates and general public.



Awareness Sessions for the students of CHSE

ACC has conducted integrity awareness sessions for the newly joined students to grade 11 of Center for Higher Secondary Education (CHSE). ACC conducted 8 sessions from 2nd to 5th March of 2020.

A total of 394 students had participated in these sessions.



Anti-corruption Trainings and Awareness Sessions

Supervisory Skills Training Program

Anti-Corruption Commission conducted an in-house training on Supervisory Skills for Section/ Unit Heads and Investigation Team Leaders. The 05-hour training was held at the Commission on 06th February 2020.

The training aimed to enhance participants' supervision skills, management and supervisory responsibilities, leadership skills, along with delegating and monitoring tasks and evaluating employee performance.

This training was facilitated by the Chief Executive Officer of Happy Market Group of Companies, Mr. Ali Ihusaan.



Awareness Sessions at Fuvamulah City under “Masalas Raajje” National Awareness Campaign

ACC has conducted awareness sessions in collaboration with Elections Commission at Fuvamulah City under “Masalas Raajje” national awareness campaign. These sessions were focused on the local council elections.

In this regard, ACC has conducted 2 sessions on Friday, 21st February 2020 for 60 candidates and 56 officials of political parties. In addition to this, a session for 62 public officials and 18 police officers of Fuvahmulah City was conducted

on Saturday, 22nd February 2020. The sessions highlighted the importance of integrity and importance of eliminating electoral corruption and also urged to vote for candidates who values integrity. The sessions were conducted by the technical staff of ACC.

“Masalas Raajje” is a national awareness campaign led by Elections Commission with the participation of 16 other institutions. This campaign is to be conducted for a duration of 1 year.



Awareness Session for the students of GN Atoll Education Center

An integrity awareness session has been conducted by ACC for the students of grade 12 of GN Atoll Education Center. The session was conducted on 23rd February 2020 at GN Atoll Education Center.

The 2 hour-session highlighted the importance of academic integrity, principles of integrity, ethical approaches of decision making, and national integrity system. A total of 26 students had participated in this session.



of patients, and organize repatriate flights to foreign countries to bring back Maldivians, send care packages to local and foreign and grant authorization permits.

Government authorities should ensure the collected personal data during this period must be kept confidential and not misused under any circumstances.

5. Ensure integrity in stimulus/packages and programs introduced during the crisis:

The stimulus and relief packages must be written properly. It must also include the name of the recipients and criteria for allocation in comprehensive manner.

Furthermore, government authorities should conduct risk assessments of any relief or stimulus program introduced related to Covid19. The risks and challenges must be taken into consideration at all times.

Also government should ensure integrity and fair means while allocating land plots and distributing resources to the laborers affected in Covid19.

6. Strengthen record management systems:

All the decisions and financial transactions related to Covid19 should be properly recorded and documented in writing, including all the necessary details and justifications. Also these documents must be filed properly and easily accessible in case of future audit or any other use.

7. Minimize chances of corruption in administrative operations:

Government should strengthen internal control and not grant full authority and responsibility to a specific individual.

Authorities should supervise their staff working from home, to minimize corruption and misuse of public funds.

This Ministry of Finance has also advised the government institutions to adhere to this guideline in order to prevent corruption risks related to work carried out during the Covid19 pandemic.

SAP 2020-2024 Workshops

The commission commenced the development of its third Strategic Action Plan for 2020 – 2024. It is being developed by a special technical committee consisting of various staff of the Commission along with the assistance of local consultant, Ms. Haifa Naeem. Workshops have been conducted to establish priority areas of the SAP and to analyze the SWOT of the organization. The consultant also had conducted interviews with the stakeholders to analyze and evaluate the strength and weakness of the commission. The development of SAP is targeted to be completed by the end of April 2020.

Release of MACL seaplane investigation Report

On 11th February 2020, the commission had released its investigation report on the Maldives Airports Company Limited (MACL) seaplane corruption. This report highlighted the corruption risks involved in the development of the new sea plane terminal. In conclusion it was reported that the case will be further investigated for corruption offences.

Publication of Annual Report 2019

The Commission published its Annual Report 2019 on 11th March 2020. This report was submitted to People's Majlis earlier on 26th February 2020.

It includes information on the functional details of the Commission along with the synopsis investigation and prevention work conducted throughout the year 2019. It also highlighted the success and challenges faced during the year 2019. The financial statement of the past year was also included in the report.



Publication of Prevention Guideline to Covid19 related corruption risks.

The commission had released a Prevention Guideline report in response to COVID19 related corruption. This report stressed to ensure fairness, transparency and accountability of administrative operations and economic relief/stimulus packages. The following are the main areas discussed in the report.

1. Maintain mechanisms for transparency and accountability:

Authorities should maintain all the administrative works related to covid19 documented and publicly accessible.

The distribution and allocation of Government Economic stimulus packages and funds/aids received from international governments should be transparent and published.

Government should strengthen the protection of whistleblowers and ensure that the whistleblower protection law is implemented

2. Minimize corruption in the financial and procurement system:

Government authorities should adhere public financing regulation standards at all times even in case of emergency.

3. Strengthen oversight mechanisms:

Government should encourage to expand investigative journalism and support people to report any corruption activities to the relevant authorities.

4. Establish social justice and ensure integrity in decision making:

Authorities must ensure integrity in making decisions such as the transfer of people to quarantine facilities, provide necessary equipment and medicines to the facilities, prioritize the treatment
